Day One – Tuesday, October 4th - Tour Day

Hosted by Westmoreland County Agricultural Land Preservation.

The Fall 2011 Conference will begin at the new Holiday Inn Express in Donegal, PA. (Donegal is located East of Pittsburgh, just off the turnpike, *approximately* 3 hours from the general Harrisburg area.) Tour guests should join everyone at the front of the Holiday Inn Express **no later than 11:15 am.** (Car pools can be organized from various locations to help with travel expenses!)

The WCALP Board will provide transportation via motor coach from the hotel to Frank Lloyd Wright's famous "Fallingwater" for a tour of the house and grounds, and a light lunch. Time permitting; the group may also tour another great spot located in the beautiful Laurel Highlands.



The tour will be free for all PFPA members; guests and non-PFPA members may attend at a nominal fee (amount to be determined.)

Day Two – Wednesday, October 5th – Conference Workshop Day



The workshop will be held at the Powdermill Nature Reserve in Rector, PA (approximately 15 minutes away from the Hotel.) Powdermill is the Carnegie Museum of Natural History's field station featuring environmental exhibits, nature trails and the perfect conservation conference facility.
